Child Find

Child Find is a program to identify, locate, and evaluate children in need of special education.

School districts are required by federal law to provide services to children, 3-21 years, who may need special education regardless of the severity of the disability.





Locating

Locating students who may have disabilities involves working with other agencies, and informing the general public of available special education services and the special education referral process.



Identifying students who may have disabilities could include screenings or Coordinated Early Intervening Services. These services are provided to students who need additional academic and/or behavioral supports to succeed in the school environment.



Evaluating students who may have disabilities is achieved through a comprehensive evaluation. This comprehensive evaluation is completed to determine whether a student is eligible for special education services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act.
